FEMA	Assists regions struck by catastrophic hurricanes.	Offers information, resources, and assistance for those affected by climate change.	Stands for Federal Emergency Management Agency.
Emergency Management Institute	Serves as the national focal point for the development and delivery of emergency management training to enhance the capabilities of State, local, and Tribal government officials.	This institute also trains volunteer organizations; FEMA's disaster workforce; other Federal agencies; and the public and private sectors to minimize the impact of disasters and emergencies on the American public.	Mission Statement: To support the Department of Homeland Security and FEMA's goals by improving the competencies of the U.S. officials in Emergency Management at all levels of government to prepare for, protect against, respond to, recover from, and mitigate the potential effects of all types of disasters and emergencies on the American people.

Department of Homeland Security	This organization requires the dedication of more than 240,000 employees in jobs that range from aviation and border security to emergency response, from cybersecurity analyst to chemical facility inspector.	This organization is responsible for monitoring and preventing terrorist attacks and enhancing national security.	Mission Statement: With honor and integrity, we will safeguard the American people, our homeland, and our values.
Oklahoma Office of Homeland Security	Is responsible for the immediate response if a terror attack takes places within Oklahoma's borders.	Monitors and prevents any threats of terror within Oklahoma communities and communicates with the Department of Homeland Security.	The duties of the office include: Developing and implementing a comprehensive statewide homeland security strategy and planning and implementing a statewide response system.
Urban Search and Rescue	Responsible for finding and rescuing the citizens of Moore, Oklahoma after the May 20th tornado when structures collapsed all over the city.	Considered a "multi-hazard" discipline, as it may be needed for a variety of emergencies or disasters, including earthquakes, storms, tornadoes, floods, dam failures, and hazardous materials releases.	Involves the location, rescue (extrication), and initial medical stabilization of individuals trapped in confined spaces.

Role	Audience	Format	Topic
Principal	Staff Members	E-mail	In this e-mail, the principal is explaining how important communication will be when preventing tragedies from taking place. Recently, a gun was found on campus and threats have been made towards the school. Encourage staff members how to communicate and work with students on reporting any situations that may arise.
Police Chief	Citizens of Oklahoma City	Public Service Announcement	A recent rise in violence has occurred due an unknown virus that has caused people to temporarily lose control of their temper. Create a calming service announcement that will air over the radio and guide people to safety. Explain how FEMA and US & R plan to respond.
