27th Anniversary Remembrance Ceremony
Oklahoma City National Memorial

On April 19, we will come together for the 27th Anniversary Remembrance Ceremony for *those who were killed, those who survived and those changed forever* by the Oklahoma City bombing on April 19, 1995.

The Ceremony is open to the public and to the media for coverage.

The start time of the Remembrance Ceremony is 8:45a.m.; seating at 8:30a.m.

At 9:02a.m. 168 seconds of silence will be observed. Family members and survivors will read the names of the 168 people killed. Additional program information is attached.

Thanks to Cox Community Day, admission to the Oklahoma City National Memorial Museum is free on April 19. The Museum will open immediately following the Remembrance Ceremony, with the last ticket at 4:00p.m.

Survivor Tree saplings will be given out in front of the Memorial Museum after the Remembrance Ceremony on a first come basis.

Media and Coverage Information

Media credentialing is required. Please email the names and email addresses/contact of those covering the April 19 Remembrance Ceremony to <https://memorialmuseum.com/press-room/mediacreds/> by 5:00p.m. Thursday, April 14. Media credentials provided by the Memorial at 6:00a.m. April 19, must be worn while covering the event.

Out of respect and at the request of family members and survivors, ALL Media must remain under the Survivor Tree during the Remembrance Ceremony. You are welcome to roam the Outdoor Symbolic Memorial before 6:45a.m. and after the conclusion of the Ceremony.

Security Sweep

Law enforcement will make their security sweep about 6:45a.m. on April 19. All media is subject to security and K9 sweeps by law enforcement. All equipment needed for coverage, must be at the Survivor Tree by 6:45a.m. Equipment will not be allowed inside the Memorial grounds after the law enforcement security sweep.

Live Pool Camera - Podium

KWTV is providing the pool podium camera – their IP satellite uplink and SDI DAs will be available on Robinson between NW 5 and 6 Streets. Distribution is also available in the KWTV parking lot, 7401 N. Kelley Avenue. Parking along Robinson is restricted to those plugging into KWTV's DA. Please find other parking for general news vehicles.

The live stream of the Remembrance Ceremony on MemorialMuseum.com is provided by KWTV because they are the pool camera. For technical support, contact Greg Ward, KWTV Ops Director, 405-706-8106.

ALL vehicles must be parked ten feet behind the cut-out at the 9:01 Gate. Parking is not permitted in the driveway between the Museum and Memorial.

No backpacks or large bags are allowed on the grounds. Media is allowed to carry backpacks for live coverage/camera equipment. Media responsible for backpacks are required to wear yellow media vests supplied by the Memorial Museum. Please return the vests after the ceremony. All items are subject to search by law enforcement and security personnel.

Audio

A mult box, provided by Edge Productions, will be at the Survivor Tree. Edge will begin feeding tone at 7:00a.m. until pre-show music begins.

Kari Watkins, President & CEO, Oklahoma City National Memorial & Museum will be available for interviews after 6:00a.m. Please email mae@okcnm.org if you'd like to set up a specific interview time.

Risers at the Survivor Tree are provided by the Memorial on a first come basis.
